Teaching for Learning

Spring 1 2020

Week 1

I hope your week has been as exciting as it has been here and that you have settled back into your usual routine after Christmas. This week has been eventful as ever and fantastic to catch up with pupils and staff. The highlight of my week was being able to teach Year 6 for a short lesson on Wednesday – they were fantastic!

Many regular meetings take place each week but here is a flavour of this week's themes. On Monday the **Senior Leadership Team** met to discuss Behaviour, Attitude and the Northway Code and then to planning for adding capacity across school to give the most potential impact for learning. The **Leadership Team** met on Tuesday to discuss plans to monitor standards within Teaching and Learning as well as key issues facing us this term. All staff met to discuss shared values across the School community and explore values we believe to be core for Northway (more about that later). On Thursday, I met with other Primary Headteachers to discuss challenges facing schools in Liverpool and to explore best practice for all learners. In preparation for our Liverpool **Attendance** Quality Mark, this morning Mrs Reilly and I met with the assessor. It was an exciting time where we could **celebrate all that you are doing** as families to boost attendance / punctuality and therefore the learning potential of each pupil. That is just a snapshot but shares some important moments.

Very soon, you are going to be asked about the values you think should be core within our **community** - values that shape **resilient global citizens**. We are considering this as a whole school, but want you as parents to have a strong input as we identify 'core' **Northway** values. Look out next week for the information. Exciting times!

Swimming (Curriculum):

Our Swimming Programme has already been so successful this year. Both Year 4 classes have enjoyed their lessons and have all progressed in their skills too. In keeping with the plan we shared in September, after taking advice from the Liverpool School Swimming Association, we will continue to focus on Years 4 and 5, with a 'top up' allocation for Year 6 children. Instead of a class getting a half term each, Year 4 and 5 will receive the equivalent of a term and a half worth of weekly swimming sessions. In making these changes, we are giving each class the most time we can to achieve the expected standard of 25m by the end of Year 6 and take their swimming potential even further.

Year 4 Lenon have a couple more weeks swimming and beginning on Friday 31st January, Year 5 Hawkings will begin Swimming.

Dog on the School site (For everyone):

Just a gentle reminder that **dogs** are **unfortunately not allowed on our school site**. This is a directive given by Liverpool (Health and Safety) to all schools and includes the whole of our site. Some children are unsure when around unfamiliar dogs and others are very frightened. **Even though you know your dog, they do not.** Dogs are also familiar with their owners and may play beautifully with their own family children, but can change behaviour when around other children.

Dogs are unable to use our school toilets. If a dog happens to go to the toilet on the playground, we are required to disinfectant for the safety of all our children. A dog did actually urinate on a pupil earlier in the year, which makes this rule all the more important.

It is therefore safer and fairer for all our children that dogs (<u>carried</u> or <u>on a lead</u>)

do not come onto our School site.

Thank you for assisting us with this important rule.

Schools often have a School Dog – in this case, schools have carried out detailed risk assessments and have parental permission for any interaction with it.
