Coronation May 5th Day:

On **Friday 5th May 2023**, Northway will be hosting a Coronation Event. This will celebrate and teach the children about what will be happening on Saturday 6th May in London, but also celebrate the Commonwealth and ask the children how they can add greatness to Great Britain. It is going to be a fun day!

During the afternoon we will be hosting a Coronation Parade. Children can come in either:

- **Best Dressed** What would you wear to the Coronation? Come in your outfit and enjoy parading as a Royal Guest. *Please don't wear anything that may get damaged or is precious.*
- **Commonwealth / National Dress** We are so fortunate to have children from many difference countries around the world. Would your child like to come dressed in clothing that would represent that culture or country?
- **Red-White-Blue Combo** Can you come dressed in a combination of Red-White-Blue to represent the Union Flag?

Children will take part in lots of learning activities linked to the Coronation during the day.

Celebration Days:

And then... On **Friday 12th May 2023**, Northway celebrates Eurovision! We have been awarded a grant to host a Eurovision Culture Fest at Northway. We look forward celebrating the Euro countries that some of our pupils come from, tasting food, learning dances and having a parade.

Strike Days ... same information:

On **Tuesday 2nd May** school will be open for children in:

- **2Windsor**
- **4McCartney**
- **6Anning** (Essential Y6 workshops have been planned)

Unfortunately, School will not be open to children in the other classes or to Key Worker children from other classes due to the shortage of teaching staff.

All children whose classes are open should still attend school, even if their sibling is affected by the strike. All members of staff who are not striking will still be working and in school. As you will be aware there are legal / national procedures that we need to follow during a strike; first and foremost a risk assessment of safety for those pupils attending.

Lessons will take place for children who are in school as normal. PE, swimming and Spanish will take place and School Lunches will still be cooked. If you would like your child to have a school meal (if they do not normally have one), please let the School Office know. All usual services will be maintained, be it within a much smaller feeling school.
